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Market Overview

The global food packaging industry in 2026 is organized around 18 major players spanning a \$1.1 trillion global market, with the competitive hierarchy reshaped by five mega-transactions completed between July 2024 and November 2025. This competitive intelligence brief profiles all 18 players - from Amcor at approximately \$22 to \$23 billion in annualized revenue to UFlex at approximately \$2.0 billion - with verified FY2025 financials, actual customer-perceived differentiation, cost structure versus competition, and geographic footprint. For publicly traded companies, figures are sourced from disclosed earnings reports; private company figures are market-informed estimates.
